Where 11 = Year (2011)
09 = Month (September) (Months are 01 to 12)
15 = Day of Month (Days are 01 to 31)
001 = Sample Number

The three digit Sample Numbers count up from 001 for samples on the same day and begin again at 001 the following day. The active day for this lot numbering system begins at 12:00 AM and ends at 11:59 PM.
