

Cancun has shown broad adaptability in trials throughout the High Plains, Idaho and in the MINDAK region.
Cancun is indeterminate, upright in its architecture and provides great yield potential to the grower.

Cancun has shown some of the best field tolerances to common bacterial blights (CBB) out of commercialized pinto varieties being used and trialed in the High Plains. High CBB tolerance can often come at the expense of other desirable traits, however Cancun's CBB tolerance is in addition to its high yield potential, archetype, or acceptable full season maturity.

Data currently shows Cancun yielding with Cowboy and on the average maturing about 3 days later than Cowboy. With the benefit of improved archetype and CBB tolerance.





- Excellent upright architecture for direct harvestability.
- Matures in about 90–94 days or approximately 3 days later than Cowboy**
- Approximate seed count is 1,113 sds./lb. compared to Cowboy with a Seed Count of 1,197 sds./lb.***

- Shown very good field tolerance to common bacterial blight strains prevalent the trialing areas.
