New!! High Yielding Short/Mid Season Pinto

Rustler <16400> has shown broad adaptability in trials throughout the High Plains, Idaho and in the MINDAK region. Rustler is semi-indeterminate, semi-upright in it's architecture and provides great yield potential to the grower in an early/mid-season maturity.

Limited data collection opportunities in the last few years limits the ability to have good comparisons to check varieties in the area; however the data from MINDAK, Nebraska, and Idaho has all been promising for this earlier maturing variety. Rustler maintains comparable yields to check varieties in the areas and has the potential for being as early as Windbreaker.

Rustler compares the closest to Windbreaker with a similar yield, maturity, and seed count; however Rustler has an improved archetype that may allow it for direct harvest. There is potential for better adaptability to different regions and potential for earlier maturity than Windbreaker as well.

The sum of these observations and data has prompted the naming and release of the variety. Revised brochures with more comprehensive yield, maturity, and seed count information from the region will be added to future brochure revisions.



- Good upright architecture that may allow for direct harvest.
- Rustler <16400> has shown to have about the same maturity as Windbreaker.**
- Approximate seed count for Rustler is 1,138 sds./lb. as compared to Windbreaker at 1,152 sds./lb.***
- Good seed color, appearance and shape.
- Resistant to Rust strains tested for at Colorado State University
- Some field tolerance to Common Bacterial Blight has been observed.
